Poultry Industry to Connect in Saint Paul for 46th Annual MPF Convention

The nation's largest regional poultry convention -- the Midwest Poultry Federation (MPF) Convention -- will be held March 14-15, 2017 at the Saint Paul RiverCentre in Saint Paul, MN. Plus, MPF is expanding its "Learn & Go" listening sessions to include topics on commodity hedging and the new poultry biosecure website for poultry growers created by the University of Minnesota.

Attendees can be assured that the MPF Convention is the place to be to gather all the latest information they need to take back to their farms and businesses.

Eastlund continued: "It's exciting to see the growth in our Exhibit Halls, and this is all very good news for our attendees who want to learn more about the latest technology, equipment, poultry health products and much more. The MPF Convention is solely focused on the poultry and everything we do - from the education workshops and networking to our two exhibits halls - revolves on our commitment to providing the absolute best in knowledge, tools and opportunities for the poultry industry."

Pre-Show Events and New Location for Welcome Reception

The convention kicks off on March 14 with a Pre-Show Nutrition and Poultry Health Symposium, which will be coordinated jointly by MPF and the North Central Avian Disease Conference (NCADC), and the annual MPF Welcome Reception.
