Attendance at the 2014 MPF Convention topped out nearly 2,500 this year – an 14% increase over last year and the highest it's been in well over two decades. The show continued its expansion into two exhibit halls with 423 booths (240 exhibiting companies) as well as educational workshops with over 40 speakers from across the world. The 44th annual Midwest Poultry Federation (MPF) Convention will be held March 17-19, 2015 at Saint Paul RiverCentre in Saint Paul, Minn. The show will feature a Pre-Show Nutrition Symposium and Welcome Reception on March 17 and exhibits and educational sessions on March 18-19.

As a nonprofit organization, all of MPF's revenue generated (after expenses are paid) from the convention goes back to its member organizations and to support poultry programs.

About MPF:

The Midwest Poultry Federation's primary purpose is to host an annual regional convention emphasizing on-farm poultry production. The convention's goal is to offer cutting-edge information to attendees through a balanced offering of exhibits and educational workshops.
