Iowa Turkey Farmer Kim Reis Honored as Outgoing President

(Buffalo, MN) – Kim Reis, a turkey farmer from Ellsworth, Iowa, was honored by the Midwest Poultry Federation (MPF) Board of Directors last month in Saint Paul, Minnesota, for his year of service as the President of MPF.

Reis oversaw the planning and execution of the 2015 Midwest Poultry Federation Convention, the largest regional poultry show in the U.S. Reis represents the Iowa Turkey Federation on the MPF Board of Directors. The convention was held March 17-19 at the Saint Paul RiverCentre.

“On behalf of MPF, I want to thank Kim Reis for his dedication and leadership to our organization,” said MPF Executive Director Steve Olson. “He has made significant contributions to our organization and his commitment to MPF has been invaluable.”

Attendance at the 2015 MPF Convention topped out at just over 2,000 this year, and the show continued its expansion into two sold-out exhibit halls with 448 booths (245 exhibiting companies) as well as educational workshops with over 40 speakers from across the world.

The 45th annual Midwest Poultry Federation (MPF) Convention will be held March 15-17, 2016 at Saint Paul RiverCentre in Saint Paul, Minn. The show will feature a Pre-Show Nutrition Symposium and Welcome Reception on March 15 and exhibits and educational sessions on March 16-17.

As a nonprofit organization, all of MPF’s revenue generated (after expenses are paid) from the convention goes back to its member organizations and to support poultry programs.
