The Tri-State Poultry Health Round Table is a forum that brings together poultry health professionals from industry and academia to share information, explore ideas and provide updates on poultry health issues. The Tri-State Poultry Health Round Table is conducted in an informal, but structured, way to facilitate information exchange.

We are happy to announce that the Spring meeting of the Tri-State Poultry Health Round Table will be held in conjunction with the North Central Avian Disease Conference (NCADC) on the day preceding the NCADC – Monday April 15th from 1pm – 5pm. The Tri-State Poultry Health Round Table will be a hybrid meeting offering both in-person and Zoom options. There will be three parts including Turkey health, Layer health and other poultry health issues. The Turkey health part will lead off with an overview given by Dr. Steven Clark. Dr. Eric Gingerich will lead off the Layer health part. An open session will begin with a presentation by Dr. Daniel Karunakaran. As in the past, the opening presentations will be followed by the “round table discussions” allowing attendees to ask questions and provide comments. The meeting itinerary is as follows:

1:15 - 1:30	Turkey session - Dr. Clark’s presentation
1:30 – 2:15	Moderated round table discussion on turkey issues
2:15 - 2:30	Break
2:30 – 2:45	Egg layer session – Dr. Gingerich’s presentation
2:45 – 3:30	Moderated round table discussion on egg layer issues
3:30 – 3:45	Break
3:45 – 4:00	Open session – Dr. Karunakaran’s presentation
4:00 – 4:45	Moderated round table discussion on poultry issues
4:45	Closing remarks and adjourn.

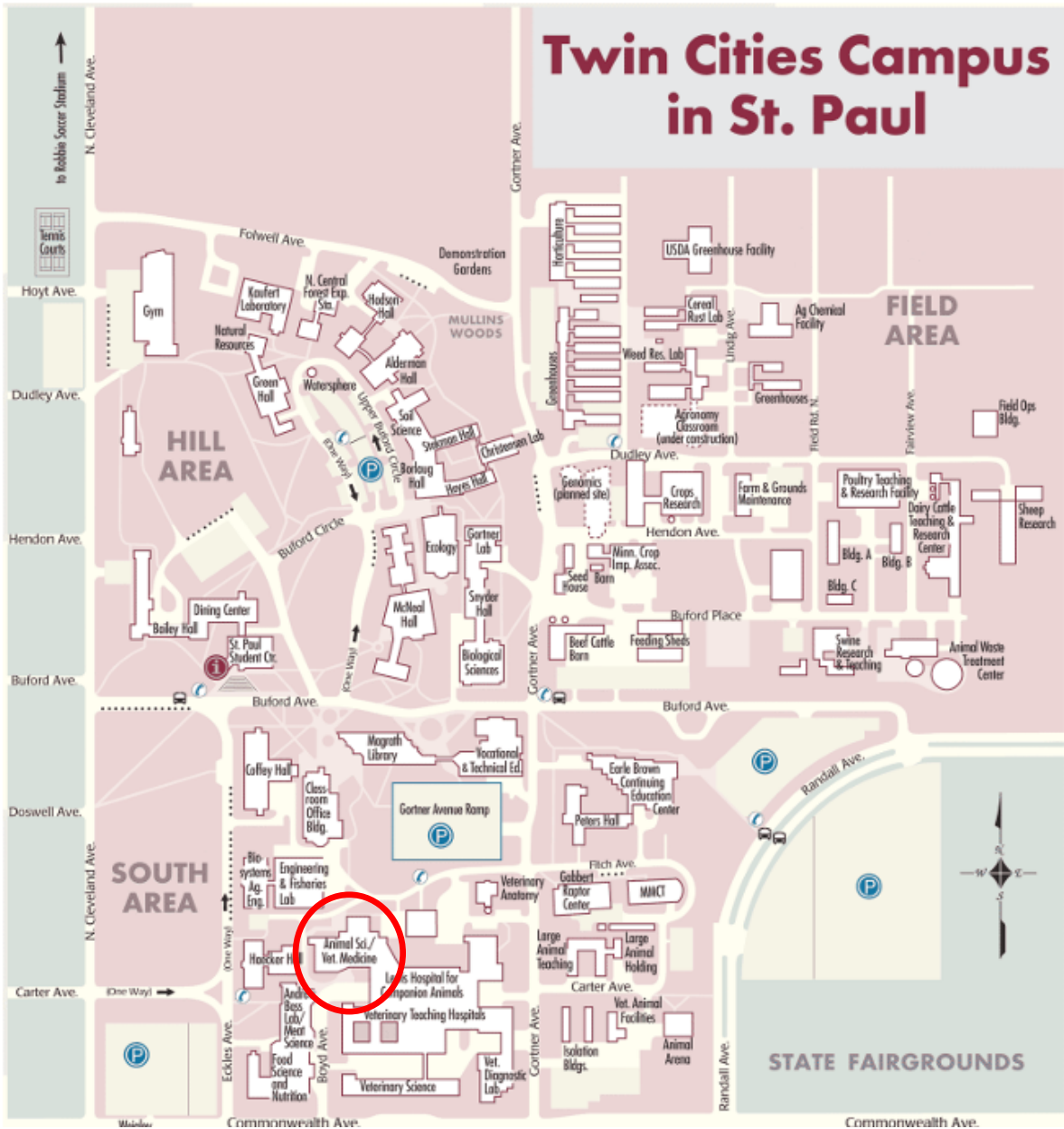
