



Crowne Plaza Renovation Project & the 2014 MPF Convention | FAQ's

- **Is Crowne still MPF's convention hotel?**
 - Yes, we've had a long standing relationship with the Crowne Plaza as our convention hotel since 1998. While we will have less attendees staying there this year, the Crowne is still our convention hotel and will continue to be through 2018.

- **What does this mean for me and my accommodations?**
 - Convention attendees who are not staying at the Crowne Plaza this year due to the construction will receive lodging accommodations at one of three other hotels. MPF will arrange to have your reservation moved to another hotel; there is nothing specific you will need to do to make this happen.

- **Will any of the costs of my new reservation at a different hotel be paid for by the Crowne Plaza?**
 - The Crowne Plaza will pay for up to *two nights' lodging plus tax* for any MPF guest that is moved to another hotel because of this renovation project. This payment will be made directly to the hotel on your behalf. (If you stay more than two nights, those costs are on your own. You are responsible for any food, beverage or incidentals during your hotel stay.)

- **How will I get to the conference at RiverCentre?**
 - A complete transportation plan will include shuttles from all overflow properties to the Saint Paul RiverCentre on a set schedule that will be provided to attendees in advance and posted on our website prior to the convention. These shuttles will drop convention attendees off at the main entrance to the convention center.

- **Will this only affect this year's conference?**
 - Yes, this construction will be complete in September of 2014. We are excited to experience the completely renovated property when we convene in Saint Paul in 2015.
